Vocational assessments are helpful for adolescents or adults who are deciding about a career path. Psychological, aptitude and personality assessments can help assist in the kind of occupation that is suitable for a person.

Support Model Assessments

Comprehensive assessment to outline the person's clinical and personal needs overall and makes recommendations on the most suitable support model and home living environment. Complex participants can benefit from a multi-disciplinary occupational therapist and forensic specialist collaboration.

Behaviour Assessments

• Functional Assessment – Behaviour & Adaptive Functioning where behaviour incidents are a concern.

Forensic - Specialist Assessments

Forensic assessments are designed to evaluate a person's psychiatric, psychological, trauma and medical history to assist in legal proceedings and to help manage risk.

- Forensic Risk Assessment of sexual, violent, and other criminal offending behaviour
 - to provide expert insights into how to manage the risks associated with these behaviours in a measured and disability-informed way.
- Cognitive and other assessments for court diversion purposes including preparing reports for Section 14 applications.

NDIS funding category is usually Improved Daily Living or Core Supports depending on which profession is required.

Assessments with a report usually require 10 – 25 hrs, some complex multi-disciplinary assessments may require additional hours.
